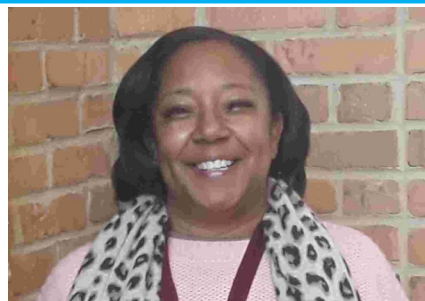

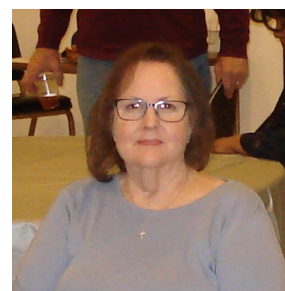

Ministries and Missions

Even though we are a small congregation, Capleville United Methodist Church does a lot for the community, through the food pantry, computer and ESL classes, and events like the egg hunt, Bible School, and Trunk or Treat. We are getting ready once again to do an Angel Tree project for the children of our food pantry.



The recent yard sale was to help us raise funds for our own church, so we can continue to stay in this neighborhood and provide spiritual and physical support for our members and neighbors. The funds are still coming from that event, but we were left with a gym full of leftovers. Even those will not go to waste. The Hispanic church was allowed to shop there, and I was allowed to pick out items that could be used for Golden Cross ministries and Room in the Inn. Last week a trunk full of blankets that were left over from our yard sale and my daughter's yard



sale went to Room in the Inn downtown. They were extremely grateful. Room in the Inn is an organization that provides shelter for the homeless, including families, especially during cold weather. Andy is also sorting out some backpacks and tote bags that Room in the Inn can give to the homeless for their belongings.

The chaplain for Wesley Homes recently told us that the residents have said they would like to have some Christmas decorations as Bible trivia & bingo prizes. The yard sale leftovers have helped us answer that wish. With a little imagination and some inexpensive add-ons, we have put together numerous Christmas prizes. A Christmas towel or hot pad, put with a pack of tuna or some hot chocolate mix, is a welcome prize. A cute little candle holder gets an LED tea light. (Candles are discouraged because of fire hazard.) Baskets are filled with shiny balls or tinsel.

Many, like the little tinsel trees, need nothing more than the usual Bible verse and some candy. There were also a lot of the stockings left over from those we made last year. Those are also going to Golden Cross. Along with a few stockings from the yard sale, they are being filled with fuzzy slipper-socks, hot chocolate mix, a package of Kleenex, and the Bible verse and candy. Those will be a welcome treat.

Thank you to everyone who helped to make the stockings, to those who contributed to the yard sale, and those who helped put prizes together.

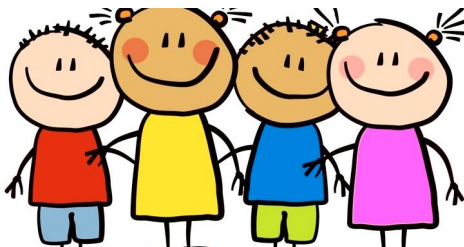

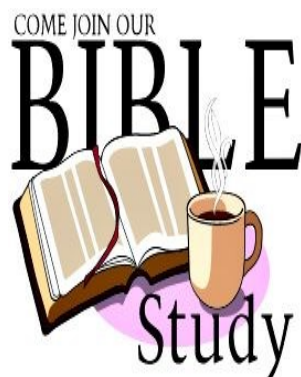

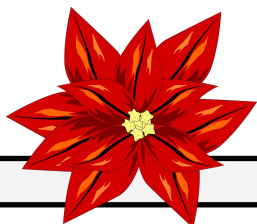
LADIES THURSDAY MORNING BIBLE STUDY
